Rooted in Pittsburgh and active across western Pennsylvania and western New York, FAM remains dedicated to strengthening communities through meaningful engagement.



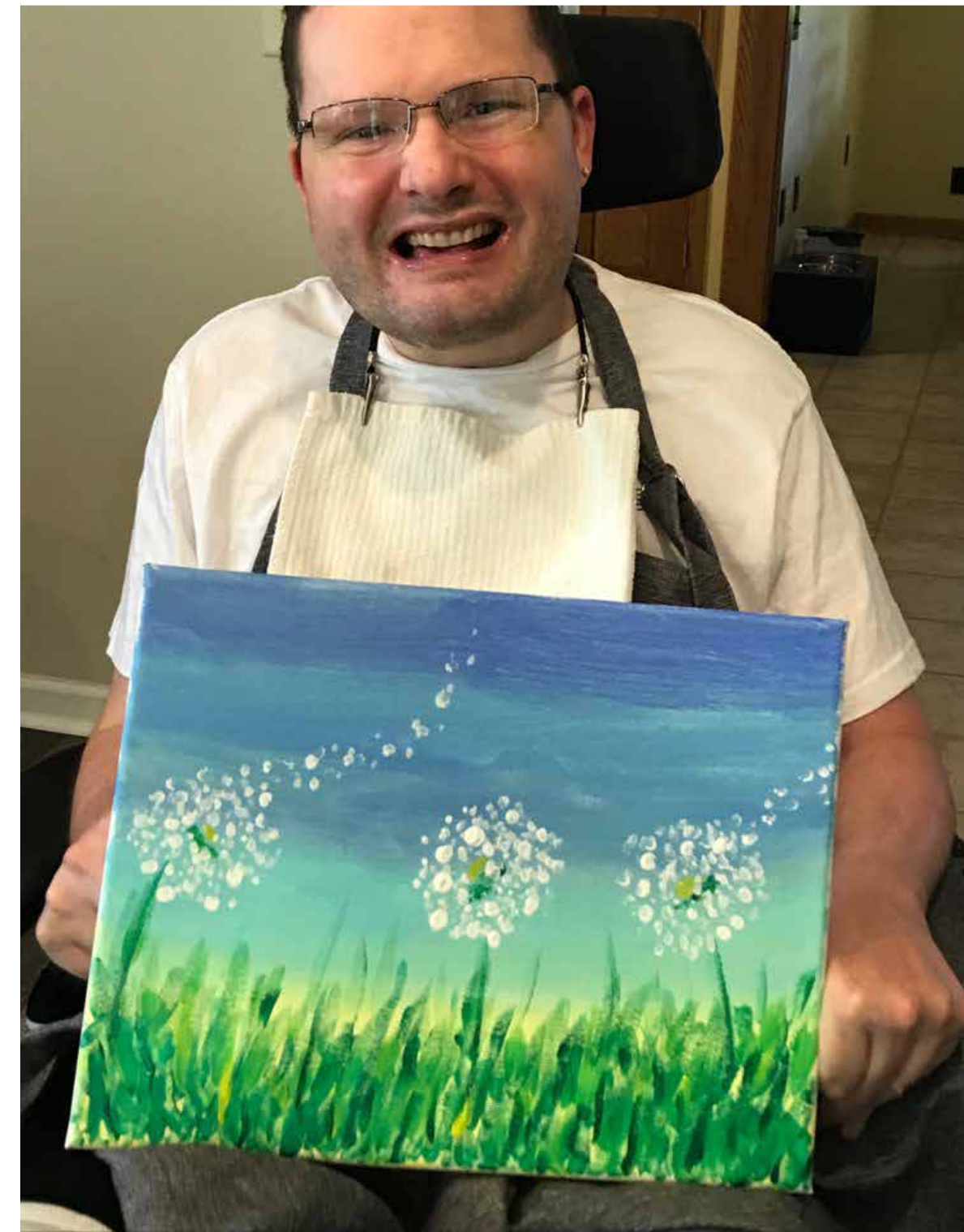

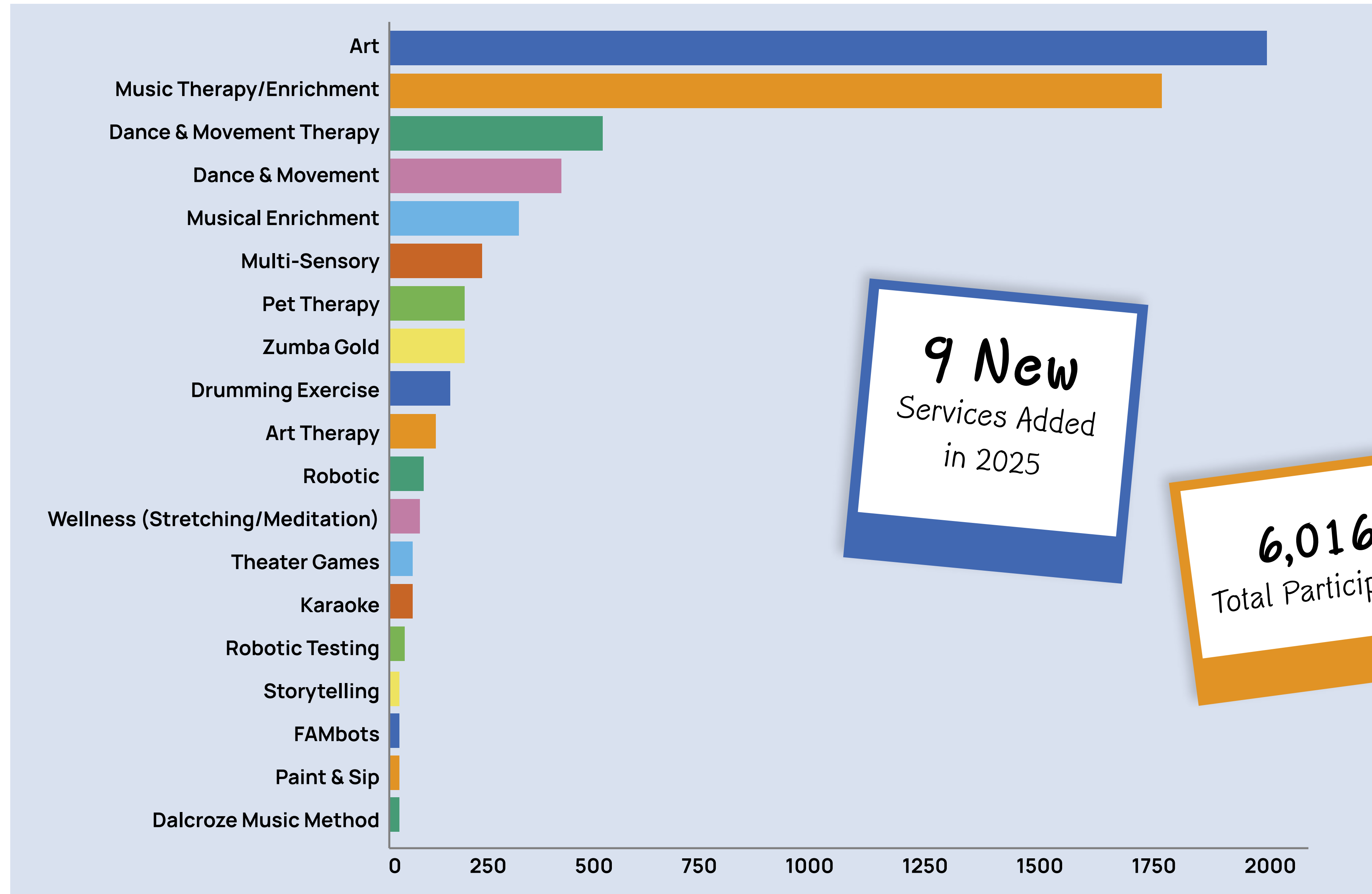

Vision Statement

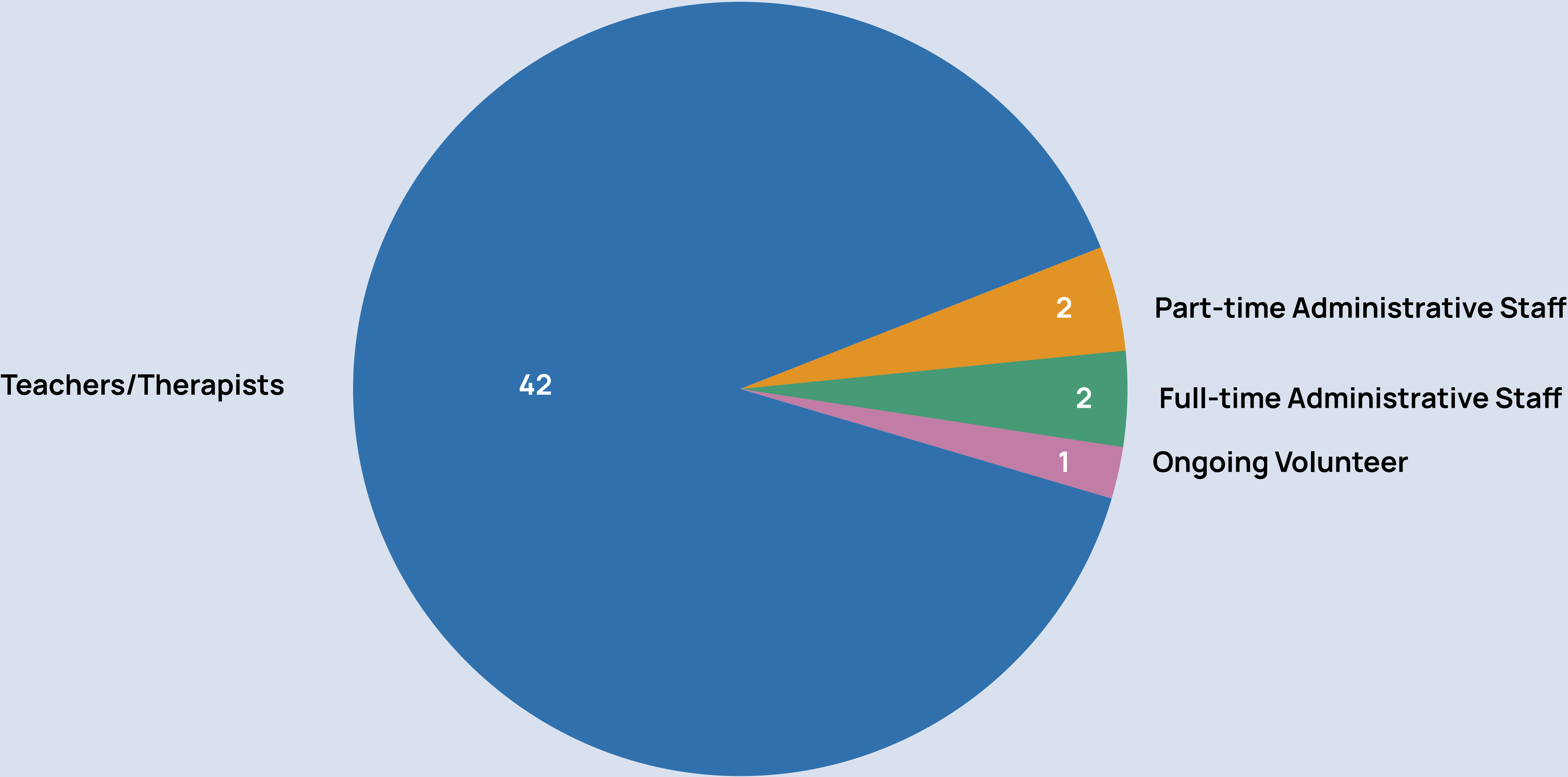
Our vision is a world where every individual experiences purpose, meaning, and connection. FAM leverages technology and creative expression to empower personal growth, communication, and social skills.

Art Therapy/Art Classes

Art therapy offers a welcoming space where creativity becomes a voice. For many children, older adults, and individuals on the autism spectrum, expressing feelings through words can feel overwhelming. Art provides a gentle, nonverbal way to share emotions, build confidence, and connect with others in a supportive environment.

At FAM, our Certified Art Therapist leads both in-person and virtual sessions designed to meet participants where they are. These sessions encourage self-expression while fostering a sense of belonging and understanding.

Creative activities also engage areas of the brain—such as the temporal lobe—that often remain active longer for individuals living with Alzheimer's or dementia. Through color, imagery, and hands-on creation, participants discover meaningful ways to communicate, reflect, and experience moments of joy and connection.

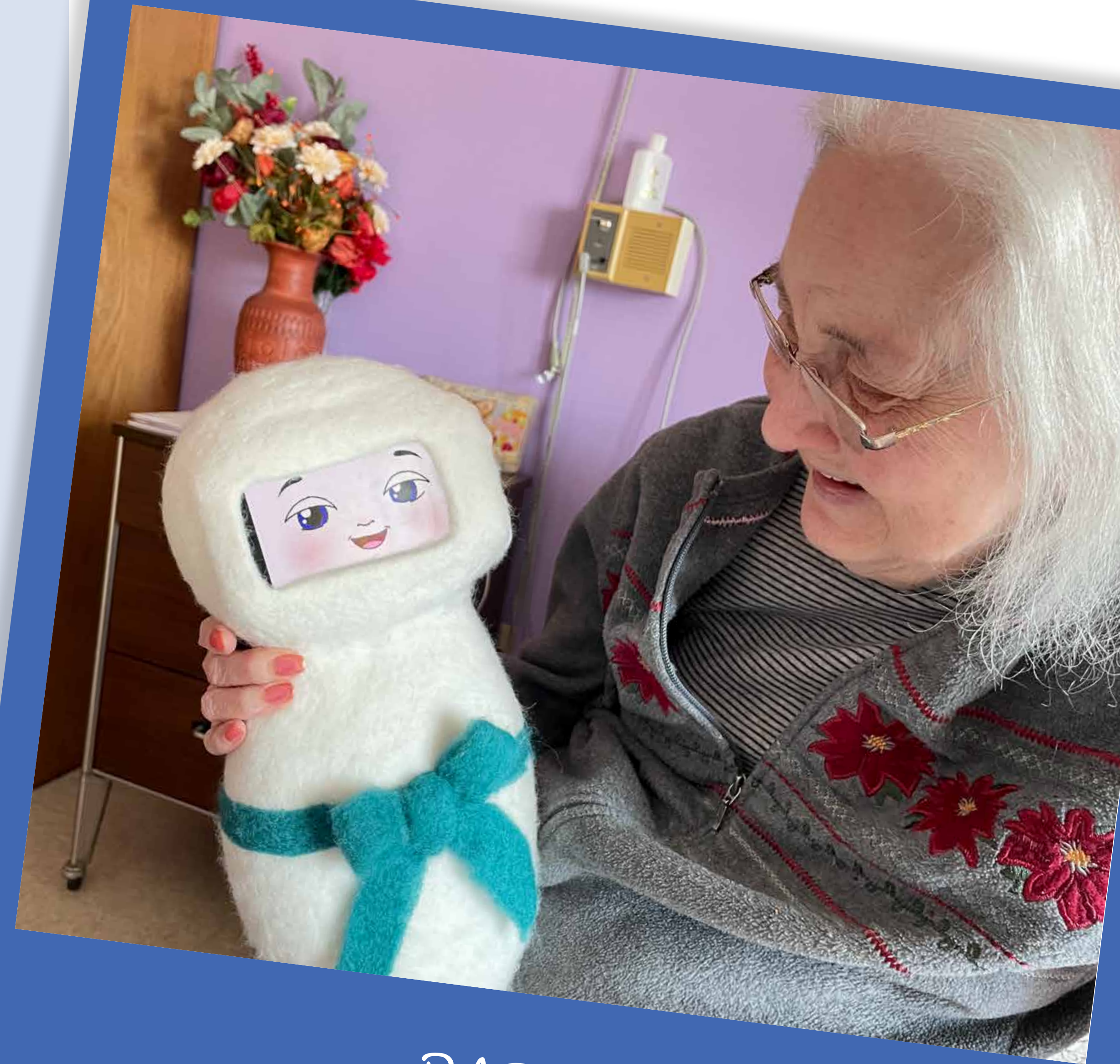
BABYbot

BABYbot is the first iteration of a social robot, thoughtfully designed to bring comfort, connection, and reassurance to individuals living with Alzheimer's Disease and other forms of dementia. Through gentle interaction, soothing responses, and familiar sensory experiences, BABYbot helps ease feelings of anxiety, restlessness, and distress.

More than fifty test subjects showed these meaningful moments of engagement spark calm, joy, and a renewed sense of connection. Just as importantly, BABYbot offered caregivers valuable moments of relief—creating space to breathe, reset, and share in positive interactions with their loved ones.

By fostering comfort and companionship, BABYbot supports not only individuals living with dementia but also the families and care partners who walk alongside them every day.

FAM continues to develop this important social robot to better combat loneliness and isolation in older adults and to reduce anxiety in children during therapy sessions. We're now in the final testing phase with excellent results so far.

Multi-sensory Sessions that gently stimulate memory and communication using aromatherapy, sensory coverings, music, and social robots—ideal for people living with dementia at home and in care facilities!

We also offer Musical Entertainment, from guitar serenades to our Trained Opera Singer (who also sings Broadway Songs and Show Tunes) and our Music History Teacher who offers “If Not Me Workshops” for all ages.
